

Guidelines for Specimen Collection and Labeling

Instrument: Alpha Wassermann ACE Alera

TEST (TEST CODE): Apolipoprotein B (APOB)

COLLECTION INSTRUCTIONS: Freshly drawn fasting specimen.

SPECIMEN TYPE: Whole Blood

COLLECTION CONTAINER: Gold top tube (SST)



COLLECTION AMOUNTS: Preferred: 2.0 mL

Minimum: 1.0 mL

REJECTION CRITERIA: Hemolyzed specimens are unacceptable.

COLLECTION TIMING: Separate serum from cells ASAP or within 2 hours

of collection.

PROCESSING SPECIMENS: Serum

PROCESSED AMOUNTS: Preferred: 1.0 mL

Minimum: 0.5 mL

PROCESSING INSTRUCTIONS: Allow specimen to clot for 20-30 minutes.

Centrifuge and immediately separate into transport

tube.

SPECIMEN STORAGE/STABILITY: **Temperature Stability**

Ambient 8 hour(s)
Refrigerated 8 day(s)
Frozen 3 month(s)

SHIPPING INSTRUCTIONS: Refrigerate specimen during transportation.

REFERENCE INTERVAL: Female: 55 – 125 mg/dL

Male: 55 - 140 mg/dL
