- 1) Completion of PH 101 and PH 102. Grade of C or better is required (not C-). Overall GPA minimum of 2.0

## The following requirements must also be met:

- 1) A total of 42 credits of upper division courses (300-level or 400-level)
- 2) Choose an Area of Focus or Minor or 2<sup>nd</sup> major. See advisor for options
- 3) Electives (usually 12-21crs) depending on chosen as Area of Focus or Minor or 2<sup>nd</sup> major
- 4) Minimum 120 credits to graduate (if doing dual degree 150 credits minimum is required)
- 5) All other University requirements as stated in the UNM Catalog
- \*\*COPH allows students to declare a second major or a second minor. Please see advisor for details
- \*\*The BSPH cannot be added as a second major to any degree program
- \*\*A grade of C (not C-) is needed for <u>all</u> courses to satisfy graduation requirements.
